
**ORDER: APPROVE LOCHLAN SUBDIVISION PHASE I PRELIMINARY AND FINAL


The vote on the motion was as follows:

**Current Children and Cases in CPS Custody**

- 72 children, increase from 46 children in October 2020
- 35 cases, increase from 25 cases in October 2020

**Current Volunteers in the CASA program**

- 28 active volunteers
- 26 assigned to cases
- 3 on leave (personal reasons,taking a break,etc)

**CASA currently serves 100% of the children in custody.**
