
**ORDER: AUTHORIZE SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING PURSUANT TO MISSISSIPPI STATUTE 19-5-105 FOR MAY 6, 2024 TO DETERMINE IF THE UNCLEAN CONDITION OF LAFAYETTE COUNTY PARCEL 192-04-032.01 IS A MENACE TO PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE**
